There is a rose garden and a new enclosed garden with a lily pond also a large pond renovated in 2016 with new plantings.

A woodland walk meanders around the perimeter of the property.

The visit is later in the month to take in the beautiful autumn colours in the arboretum.

6. Cut lawns while the grass is still growing
